This is a highlight of a few KEY points The Orangeman relies on to tell you why you should vote for him. Among them, inflation, and illegal immigration, even though he never passed a significant immigration bill in his first 2 years as President, when he had all 3 branches of government majority Republican. Also included, a brief explanation on his 7 million vote loss in 2020.

On **INFLATION**. Trump did \$8.175 trillion in increased national debt in 4 years. By comparison, Obama did \$9.548 trillion in 8 years. Inflation.

Simple statement here that is detailed more later in the book. From March of 2022, the beginning of the Ukraine war, and over the next 12 months, Exxon/Mobil made almost \$60 billion dollars in RECORD profit. This company normally would make up to \$15 billion in non-war-time. They made \$14.3 billion in 2019. All the other big names cleaned up too. The next time a POLITICIAN or FINANCIAL news network person says 'we need to drill more oil' as attack on Biden for high gasoline costs, think

The total combined votes that these 4 Republican members won their last election by, November 8, 2022, was 1500 votes LESS than the ONE Democrat's total votes, in beating her opponent. PERFECT example of gerrymandering! 4 Republican's total margin of victory 23,179. The vote total victory margin for One Democrat was 24,679!

Here are some examples of how the Electoral College tilts Presidential elections. We all know Hillary won the popular vote by 3 MILLION and lost 3 swing states by a total of 77,723 votes. These 3 states gave Trump the victory. He won Michigan by 10,713 votes, Wisconsin by 22,718, and Pennsylvania by 44,292.

In 2020, when Biden beat Trump by just over 7 million votes, Biden won by 253,530 votes in the 3 same states. In Michigan, by 154,188 votes, Wisconsin by 20,682, and Pennsylvania by 81,660.

Trump went after these 3 states even though he LOST them by more than TRIPLE the votes that Hillary Clinton had lost to him by in 2016. Interestingly, those 3 states have a large Black population that really pushed the Biden vote in the areas of Philadelphia, Detroit, and Milwaukee.

Oh, and you want to talk about Trump pressuring Georgia and Arizona to flip the election in his favor? He must be weak in math, because even if Trump did get those two states electoral votes he would still have come up short in reaching the required goal of 270. The result of these companies taking advantage of all those [GOOD](#) people in those southern states, according to Federal Reserve data in the 4th quarter of 2021, was that

1% of the country's population NOW has about 1/3rd of the nation's wealth.

The Constitution does NOT have the word **slavery** in it, but this was a key debating point for representation in voting and business interests. The slave state representatives pushed for the Three Fifths Compromise, which would allow states to count 3/5ths—or 60% of slaves in their states—toward representation in Congress, which gave those states an advantage/increased number of congressional seats, mostly favoring southern states.

Certainly, this is one of the contributing reasons that even though the greatest concentration of White voters were in the north, the south—specifically the Carolinas and Virginia—produced 9 of the first 12 Presidents.

Chapter 8: The Orangeman's Love of Tyrants and Criticism of Our Allies' Military Spending.

It's really not possible to look back in our lifetimes and see a President that so gleefully has attacked our allies with insults in stark contrast to the brotherly-like love he has shown the sawed-off runt in North Korea, the Stalin disciple in Russia, or the dictator in Turkey. Trump idolizes all of them in one way or another for their strong-arm tactics of ruling. To keep my 5th grade level RAG in line with that mission, let's understand that that the US military being located in these ally countries is NOT just to protect them, but to also serve as jumping off spots to protect our interests worldwide, be it business or military.

NATO, the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, was created with Canada, the US, and Western Europe in 1949. That was followed by a Security Treaty with Japan in 1951, another one with Australia and New Zealand, known as ANZUS, and a Mutual Defense Treaty with South Korea, all by 1953. These agreements, led by

the US, have fought for a system that promotes human rights, democracy, free economies, and generally protection for those without a voice.

Why do any of this? Well, let's look at China as one example. They are in Africa attempting to control its natural resources through providing infrastructure projects and other tempting enticements. These projects have led many of these countries to incur debt with China, which could very well lead to China "owning" these individual countries assets/resources.

The point is that to demonize our allies over whether they pay their fair share in global contributions, you really have to look at examples of ways they may contribute that you may not be aware of. Since Eisenhower, Presidents have complained of allies under-contributing. Obama and Trump both recently pushed that line of reasoning, and after the 2014 Russian invasion of the Crimean Peninsula in Ukraine, these NATO members agreed to a 2% target of military spending based on their GDP.

WOW, it's February of 2024 and 3 countries are spending more than 3%. The US is second behind Poland and above 3rd place Greece, and 8 more countries are above 2%. The Orangeman just stated that **he would let Putin go after countries that weren't spending 2% of GDP on military.**

Think about this, many of these countries that are un-

der the 2% spending **DON'T produce the weapons that they are required to buy** and don't have the companies making them and employing workers that benefit the American economy in untold ways. Also, since we consume approximately 20% of the world's resources every day and make up only 4.25% of the world's population, we certainly have more responsibility than any other **FREE** nation to ensure the safety of the planet from tyranny since we benefit greater than anyone else in maintaining our standard of living.

Our position as the world's largest exporter of weapons is well defined in the link below. It shows we are supplying more than 100 countries with weapons at a rate of approximately 4 times as much as the second-place supplier.

Keep in mind, the first year in office a new President inherits the budget of the previous administration. That number can change during the year depending upon the needs of the nation, as I stated in the introduction, I am using the fiscal years Presidents were in office, as called out in the link above. Let's put into perspective the **almost triple** increase in the national debt the great prompt-reader, I mean communicator, had in relation to other Presidents.

Chapter 12:

The Following Years: Bush Sr. and Bill Clinton

George Bush Sr. came into a tough time with the Iraq War, Recession, and the Savings and Loan crisis. Debt went from **\$2.602 trillion to \$4.065** billion in his 4 years. Third-party candidate Ross Perot probably cost Bush a second term as he took more votes from Bush than he did from Clinton.

Bill really lucked out as the technology industry exploded while he was in office from 1993 and ended up at **\$5.674 trillion** of debt in his last year 2000, an increase of only **\$1.609 trillion**. Much of this smallish amount of debt increase from his 8 years in office can, in addition to the technology explosion, be attributed to his 1993 tax increases, which probably led to Republican gains in Congress.

BUT, in 1999, Clinton signed The Financial Services Modernization Act which was sponsored by 3 Republicans, Senator Gramm and Representatives Leach and Bliley—aka the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act which would replace the Glass-Steagall 1933 Act that was put in place

after banks crashed during the depression. Banks in the late 1990s said they needed the new legislation to compete with foreign firms.

The problem was, we were now allowing insurance companies and brokerage/stock trading companies to merge with banks. Well, in my business experience, dealing with a banker is a much more conservative way of obtaining a loan than what I witnessed in the early 2000s. At that time, the trouble, as I saw it, was that mortgage originators got \$150 to write up a loan at any of these newly created home mortgage companies. Many times, the applications were not truthfully filled out.

An example: the borrower may have been receiving money from a relative and not disclosing it on application. You would think that simply looking into 3 years of a borrower's bank statements would reveal that.

That is just one example of how borrowers that got loans were unprepared to take on home ownership, let alone the fact that many took on adjustable-rate mortgages just to qualify.

The point of these companies SELLING these mortgages to so many unqualified borrowers was, that they could then package them and dump them on investors, which may be Wall Street firms or even foreign banks. When interest rates rose, and these adjustable-rate mortgages came due, the result was something we all had to pay for, and, in most cases, the companies that benefited

from this Ponzi-like scam walked away with the profits. Interestingly, we really have learned nothing, as a significant percentage of home buyers today have put down very little or even have a seller put up the closing costs, and now that interest rates have NORMALIZED how do they sell that home, if needed, to the next unqualified buyer? It is March of 2024, and right now, with these minimum requirements to buy the few homes that are available on the market, this is not a problem. But, any hiccup in the economy and it only makes sense that we will see many failures again. And all us dopes know how that turned out in 2008.

Quick personal story. When I started out as a licensed real estate agent in the mid-seventies, the older brokers gave me a bit of advice. They said, “never put anyone in your car with less than 20% down, you can do the 10% down VA (Veteran’s Administration) or FHA (Federal Housing Administration), but it will take months and many don’t close, even after all the work that is required.” Funny, but for the last 30 years, you only need a pulse to qualify for a mortgage. In way too many cases, when the time comes to buy, you even get a parting gift of more money than the house costs when you leave the closing!

Another wonderful solution for people in trouble with these NO MONEY DOWN purchases is the government giving failing mortgage holders PARTIAL CLAIM MORTGAGES. They allow the borrowers to put all their

unpaid payments into an interest-free mortgage that is set aside separate from their original mortgage and HOPEFULLY paid off when they sell or refinance some-day. Today, in 2024, you can sell a house quick, but how long that will last? No one knows.

When these no money/next to no money down mortgages fail due to illness, divorce, death, or job loss, all of us that didn't over extend ourselves get to eat that loss as is reflected in higher borrowing costs OR, in the case of government backed mortgages, we all get to pay higher taxes to balance these losses. Can't always blame the borrower, but the results are the same.

If you want to read a great article on how it happened by way of approval by all 3 branches of government, you can read the quick article at bottom of page, OR NOT. Don't want to stray too far from what we all want, which is a quick read and highlights.

Quick Note: To see how much our perception of the value of a dollar has been crushed, the article gives a final cost of \$500 billion dollars for the 2008 crash, after some was paid back. Unlike the 2020 FREE money which many undeserving people and companies took without much, if any, strings attached and NEVER paid back, even if they never needed it. AMERICAN SOCIALISM, we're all in on it!! **Example: a family business that took a couple hundred thousand and stated they didn't really need the money, but it was about time the government**

gave them back something. They think The Orangeman did SOME good things, like signing that 2020 no strings attached money that many took. But you see how people become corporate socialists, even at a small level, if they can access FREE money. Now I believe that some smaller companies, pick a number, \$10 million or less in yearly revenue, should have received help IF they did really need it. You can read more of this, some repeated, in **Chapter 18.**

Really makes us aware of how much the dollar has been crushed when you realize that the debt increased **\$9.548 TRILLION** under 8 years of Obama and **\$8.175 trillion** under 4 years of Trump. Don't get side-tracked by comparing the reasons for their amounts. Ya, Obama inherited the crash of 2008 and money was worth more prior to 2008, and Trump got the pandemic.

Chapter 13:

George Bush JUNIOR Years.

How can we forget the President Cheney years?

OOPS, I mean George JR years?

Neocons trying to install Democracy in the Mideast, didn't any of them watch Lawrence of Arabia? NEVER gonna happen. The President's ALL Neocon cabinet all thought 9/11 was their excuse to invade the Mideast. Damn, even I thought that meant cheap oil for all, what a dope.

I wandered there for a minute, back to George JR.

Chapter 14:

The Obama years.

homes, AT LEAST 15 times DEPENDING ON WHERE YOU LIVE IN AMERICA! If you're in an area such as the Boston suburbs, you've seen more like a 20-time increase the cost of a home since 1974. So, how do we justify minimum wages that, in many states, are still at \$7.25 an hour? NEW HAMPSHIRE is a great example, as it is surrounded by all northeast states that are approaching double that pay rate. Of course, many forward-thinking states, which in some cases are more expensive to live in, pay \$15 per hour. But, no matter where you live, you can see how \$2.00 an hour in 1974 would be more like \$30 or more per hour today. We seem to be intent on crushing the people in retail and the majority of lower-level health care workers, and of course no one gets more of a beating than those NO GOOD UNDOCUMENTED FARM workers, who are greatly underpaid, and don't we all need these food workers and health care workers in our daily lives?

Back to Obama. Most of us don't remember but Obama's 2010 tax cuts reduced revenue in the following years and was one of the reasons that may have led to continued trillion-dollar deficits. In 2015, with the help of falling oil prices, the yearly deficit was reduced to approximately \$442 billion dollars. WOW, will we ever see a yearly increase in debt ever be that low again!! What a joke. So, Obama's first year in office, 2009, the national debt started at \$10.025 trillion and his last, 2016, was

Chapter 15:

Trump Praising Putin.

Influence Peddling by Trump and Biden.

Of course, The Orangeman’s television entertainment mouth pieces agree and cover these treasonous quotes by saying, Putin’s ok, he’s not that baaad, why do we care? One reason is, Putin has stated for the last 20 years that he wants to go back to the USSR days, and that means even NATO countries bordering Ukraine. If the mines cannot be worked without the aid of such men let them be closed. No business should be operated in Iowa that will not pay wages on which a man can bring up a family of Americans—citizens of whom the best of their country men are proud.

Next, the Irish.

Escaping famine and looking for a better life, the Irish came to America in large amounts and were less than welcomed, especially the Catholics. Think about it, as late as the 1960s many did not want an Irish Catholic American like John Kennedy to be President.

"I am not the Catholic candidate for president," JFK declared in 1960. "I am the Democratic Party's candidate for president, who happens also to be a Catholic."

Now the Germans.

Trump's father's claim of being Swedish is a good example and a result of the treatment Germans received in America.

The German people mainly came in the later part of the 19th century. They integrated into American society quickly, bringing business activities such as breweries and restaurants with them. Prior to the Great War (WW1) they were living a fairly normal American life, but once war broke out and America became involved, German Americans were suspected of possible treason and in many cases were treated that way. 1914:

Typhoid Vaccination Becomes Commonplace in the United States. By 1914, typhoid vaccination had moved beyond military forces in the United States and into use for the general public.

Parke, Davis & Company sent the letter to a Philadelphia physician to suggest the use of typhoid vaccine for travelers.

The text of the letter reads as follows:

Dear Doctor: -

Your patients, many of them, will soon be leaving for their vacations and unless protected by vaccination they may incidentally be in some danger of contracting Typhoid Fever.

As a preventive of Typhoid Fever, the value of Typhoid Vaccine is now well established. It has been used extensively in our own and other great armies with very satisfactory results. Consequently, in the U.S. Army anti-typhoid vaccination of recruits is now compulsory.

It is a simple matter to use Typhoid Vaccine Prophylactic (P.D. & Co). Three doses are given, injected subcutaneously at ten-day intervals. It is offered in packages containing enough for the protective treatment of one person – three doses in three bulbs, three doses in three syringes or three doses in one graduated syringe. It may also be had in a larger package known as the “hospital size” and containing enough for ten persons.

The interesting and important subject of typhoid vaccination is presented concisely in the enclosed booklet which we commend to your careful attention and we shall be very glad to supply additional information if you desire it. Supplies of Typhoid Vaccine Prophylactic, (P.D. & Co.), may be obtained through pharmacists.

Boys Sent to France for Rabies Vaccine.

In Newark, New Jersey, four boys were bitten by a rabid dog. A fundraising effort arose to help send the boys to France for treatment by Pasteur. Donors raised \$1,000, which sent the boys overseas via ocean liner.

The healthy boys returned home in January 1886 after treatment with the new rabies vaccine. The long incubation period of the rabies virus gave the boys enough time to travel thousands of miles for the post-exposure vaccination.

Don't fool yourself. Chapter 20: The PRICE of: OIL Groceries Fast Food

FACTS: The US Energy Information Administration reported on January 2022 that 601 Oil and Gas Rotary rigs were in service. Just prior to the pandemic in January 2020, there were 791. In August 2020, that number stood at 250 as the world's use of energy dropped dramatically due to the pandemic.

We saw that happen with one of our most visible daily petroleum products, gasoline. Those rigs closed due to the crash in prices and, as an example, because the break-even price for drilling oil varies from \$43-\$55 dollars in different areas of the US, drillers were concerned about spending money to reopen those rigs until a barrel reached \$70. Once again, the expense of opening only to have prices subsequently fall is crushing to many of the small drillers. So, you can see why there were so many drilling company bankruptcies in 2020, why there are so many permits to drill that have not even been used, and

why no one in the industry is worrying about creating NEW permits. The permits are good for 10 years. So, the incentive to overproduce is not there when creating new wells is extremely expensive. It will even hurt oil producers when there are too many wells and, consequently, too much oil on the market.

Note: It's March 14, 2022, and May oil futures have fallen to slightly above \$100 a barrel from \$130 a barrel just last week. I'm sure they will fluctuate up and down until there is some sort of conclusion in Ukraine.

June, 2024. The price of a barrel of oil has been holding in the mid to high \$70s. This has been true all year. So, you can see how dangerous it is for oil companies to overproduce when markets swing so wildly.

For years, until recently, the retail gasoline station operators made pennies per gallon. I explain below how as of February 28, 2022, these margins have remained strong and historically high for those who OWN gas stations and buy the gas without paying a middleman. The large oil companies that own or lease their stations also enjoy this windfall.

So, along with the rigs opening, more business activity, personal use back to normal, retailers holding onto margins, the dramatic DEVALUATION of your dollar over the last 14 years, and incurring enormous debt, all your daily needs have skyrocketed in price.

The man Neil Cavuto put on air to talk about gas station profits was NOT telling the whole story. In the summer of 2022, they were repeating the old complaint that mom-and-pop stores are making pennies on a gallon.

In the northeast Mass/ NH, for example, gasoline was \$4.10 a gallon delivered to stations (June 20th week of 2022) and retail remained at \$4.79-\$4.99. Taking into account that an additional 10 cents is added to that \$4.10 price if credit cards are used, then the retailer who owns their own station is currently making between 60 and 80 cents per gallon.

To put it in historical perspective, in the 1990s you could make 12-18 cents on the gallon if you owned the station. With the value of today's dollar, you could expect that number to be 24-36 cents in comparison to the 90s.

This is true whether you are a small owner or a large corporation, as long as the small retailer owns his station without borrowing from an oil distributor for tanks, pumps, dispensers, etc. These distributors will charge the gas station operator/owner MUCH MORE than a hard money lender and keep the gas station owner in the dark about the true daily cost of fuel. The operator/owner will make pennies while the distributor, who is in between the large oil company tanks and the retailer, takes 90% of that profit. On the other hand, if a no-name gas operator, like I was, OWNS stations without help from any other

than a regular bank, that owner/operator has been having the **BEST YEARS OF THEIR LIVES!**

October 1, 2022, and gas margins have shrunk! To 45-50 cents per gallon, still a screwin'. Exxon/Mobil made \$17.8 billion in profits for second quarter 2022. More than a year's profit in 90 days!

ALL WAR PROFITEERING.

From March of 2022, the beginning of the Ukraine war, and over the next 12 months, Exxon/Mobil made almost \$60 billion dollars in RECORD profits, they would normally make \$15+- billion in a non-war time.

All other big names cleaned up also.

PURE WAR PROFITEERING. Helping to turn us all against one another, while the ENERGY companies clean up. **When you see the price of RBOB (Gasoline) on the futures market daily, add, on average, depending on what state you live in, 40-55 cents, and that's what a retailer who owns a station is paying** IF he doesn't owe a distributor! As you can see it is simple WAR PROFITEERING. Example: In the case of grocers, **Kroger** had a banner year in 2022, as did ALL grocers.

Yet, the pay workers receive is NOT enough to buy food and fix a muffler in a week. The company's **May 2024 stock values are at all-time highs.**

A little bit of interesting info here. Kroger, since 2022, has been trying to purchase the second largest grocer in America, Albertsons. Together they will dominate sales in many regions of the country. This deal is pending FTC approval. Yet, a living wage is not available to most of the workers at any of these retailers. The FTC looks to block the \$25 billion merger between grocery giants Albertsons and Kroger, calling the proposed deal anti-competitive. The Federal Trade Commission said combining the two companies under one roof would raise prices for shoppers and lower wages for workers. Below is the latest article from the FTC website. Kroger, whose brands include Ralph's, Harris Teeter, King Soopers, and Fred Meyer supermarket chains said in a statement Monday, that the FTC's move would **"hurt the very people the FTC purports to serve."**

"[O]ur proposed merger with Albertsons will mean even lower prices and more for America's consumers..."

Kroger stock has doubled since the fall of 2019. Enough said. Bend over and take it as food and fuel just continues to pound youuu!

May 10, 2024, a March Federal Trade Commission report shows that the 3 largest grocers “accelerated and distorted” the cost of food caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. When was the last refinery built in the United States?
As of January 1, 2023, there were 129 operable petroleum refineries in the United States.

The newest refinery in the United States is the Texas International Terminals 45,000 b/cd refinery in Channelview, Texas, which started operating in February 2022.

However, the newest refinery with significant downstream unit capacity is Marathon's facility in Garyville, Louisiana. That facility came online in 1977 with an initial atmospheric distillation unit capacity of 200,000 b/cd, and as of January 1, 2023, it had a capacity of 596,000 b/cd.

Capacity has also been added to existing refineries through upgrades or new construction. Some recent examples of large increases include:

In 2012, Motiva upgraded its refinery in Port Arthur, Texas, making it the largest U.S. refinery, with a capacity of 626,000 b/cd as of January 1, 2023.

In 2015, Valero expanded its Corpus Christi, Texas refinery after previous expansions, bringing its capacity as of January 1, 2023, to 290,000 b/cd.

PROPANE:

Let me give you a quick personal story about propane. On September 9, 2019, I was paying \$2.19 a gallon for propane as long as I purchased a minimum of 400 gallons a year, the maximum capacity of a 500-gallon tank. I just called my same supplier in mid-April 2024 and was told that the current price under those same terms is now \$4.09.

Let's take a look at what I believe is the difference in cost as well the increased profit these dealers are getting based on the following best available information.

The Mount Belvieu Texas Spot Price (see link below) was floating around 45 cents during this September 2019 time period. It could have been more or less when the propane company bought and transported it to their storage facility by rail. The current price on the day I recently called, in April of 2024, was just under 80 cents a gallon. So, let's use 80 cents. The 2024 April price of \$4.09, minus the September 2019 price of \$2.19, leaves us with a \$1.90 difference. Using a total inflation rate for 2020 up to the projected end of 2024, as seen in (the second link below), which totals 21.80 percent, that would equal 47 cents.

We can also attribute a price difference of 35 cents in wholesale cost at Mount Belvieu when comparing 2019 to 2024. What's left is an increase of \$1.08 a gallon over what we were all paying in September 2019. Now, suppliers will tell you that the total volume for the winter of 2023-2024 is down because of the warm winter. You can see the stock values of the publicly traded large propane companies are down, in step with these facts.

But why are we, consumers, supposed to pay this increase? We're all in this together, right? NOT!

As I repeatedly mention, these fuel companies and the food companies are the main WAR PROFITEERS in these times. I hope I have shown you how they have not only made huge profits since the pandemic and Ukraine war but have done so knowing we need food and fuel every day, not like other discretionary purchases that we can put off.

Roosevelt, who did many good things such as conservation of land, in my mind the father of land preservation in America, with regards to Secretary of State Seward who purchased Alaska for 7 million dollars from the Russians.
